

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The EDA & CDA, in collaboration with the BDA & IDA, request submissions for an international conference, "**Multilingual and Cross-Cultural Perspectives on Dyslexia**". This is the third event in a continuing series of conferences on the topic of 'Multilingualism and Dyslexia'. The first was held in Manchester, England in 1999 and the second was held in Washington, DC, USA in 2002.

The target audience will include classroom and special education teachers, dyslexia and specific learning disability specialists, cross-linguistic and cross-cultural researchers, psychologists, medical and legal professionals, speech-language therapists, English as a Second Language and foreign language teachers as well as clinical and school administrators.

300 word proposals may be submitted for symposia (3-4 presenters with facilitators), or for individual sessions, some of which may be grouped as a series addressing specific themes. Speakers who are accepted for presentation will have their registration fees waived for the day(s) they are scheduled to present. Accepted speakers are expected to pay costs for their own transportation, accommodation, meals and special events. Guidelines for submitting an abstract will be available on the conference website.
